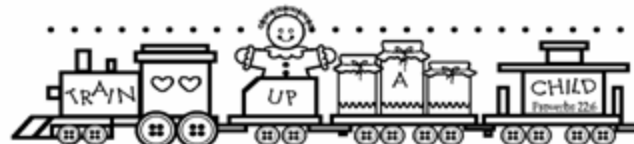

Our Mission is to glorify God by providing Christian education to children through communicating Christian values, and by providing a program of academic excellence. Innovation School of Excellence, Inc. is committed to the total growth and development of your child. Therefore, we will continuously promote spiritual, social, emotional, physical intellectual and character development. Our programs are based on age levels to assist in meeting the needs of each child. Utilizing a combination of the *ABeka*, *Wee-Learn*, and *SRA Reading Mastery* curriculums, we will provide an environment that surpasses regular academic standards.

Christian Atmosphere Christ is at the head of all that we do. Innovation School of Excellence practices and teaches Christian morals and ethics based on biblical foundations. Child Development Center (6 wks-2 yrs)

ISE provides infants and toddlers with a caring, happy, purposeful and challenging environment in which children can feel secure and confident to take advantage of the broad and varied activities and experiences available. Children learn through structured play, with an emphasis on early literacy.



Christian Academy (K3-8th Grade)

ISE offers a full academic program for grades pre-kindergarten through eight. Preschoolers are worked with in the areas of intellectual, social and emotional development, hygiene and body movement. We also employ the use of center activities, which reinforce skills taught in groups and promote language development. Kindergarten concentrates on phonics, reading, numbers, printing, Bible, scripture memorization and proper behavior. Our elementary students receive a solid foundation in the traditional academic subjects. During the transition from child to young adult, our middle school students learn individual responsibility, personal integrity, and critical thinking. ISE maintains high scholastic and discipline standards while providing Christian education to a wide range of students, including those with learning challenges.



After School Program (K5-8th Grade)

Our after school enrichment program offers a fun and educational environment that involves the utilization of the arts and athletics. Students are also afforded a period of academic reinforcement. Transportation is provided from selected surrounding Leon County public schools.

Tuition and Fees

Registration Fee: \$50 for one child, \$100 for multiple children. Fee is non-refundable.

Re-Enrollment Fee: \$15 per child. Re-enrollment fees must be paid in February to secure an existing student's spot for the upcoming year. Fee is non-refundable.

ISE accepts Early Learning Coalition (ELC), VPK, Step Up for Students & McKay. ELC doesn't cover 100% of tuition rates. ELC recipients are assessed the portions that is not covered (See the Corporate Office). Annual fees are also non-refundable.

K4-8th Grade students must be screened to determine placement and identify special needs. ISE observes a birthday cut-off deadline of September 1st to enter into K3 & up. Additional entry requirements may be required.
